

Regulations of the Professor Aleksander Zelias International Conference on Modelling and Forecasting of Socio-Economic Phenomena

I. General Provisions

1. These regulations specify and clarify the rules for participation in and organization of the 19th Professor Aleksander Zelias International Conference on Modelling and Forecasting of Socio-Economic Phenomena, which will be held on 11-14 May 2026 in Zakopane.
2. The conference is organized by the Department of Statistics at the Institute of Quantitative Methods in Social Sciences of the Krakow University of Economics and the Committee of Statistics and Econometrics of the Polish Academy of Sciences.
3. The purpose of the conference is to promote and disseminate the results of research in the fields of statistics, econometrics, and economic forecasting carried out in Polish and foreign research centers and institutions, to integrate the scientific community of Polish statisticians and econometricians and foreign academics cooperating with them, and to create new directions of research.
4. Participation in the conference implies acceptance of these regulations.

II. Registration for Participation

1. Participants of the conference must register through the online registration form available on the conference website.
2. Registration requires completion of the form and payment of the conference fee by March 10, 2026.
3. Participants may submit scientific presentations (papers, posters) following the guidelines available on the conference website. Submissions will be reviewed by the Scientific Committee of the conference.

III. Conference Fees

1. The conference fee varies and depends on the form of participation chosen by the participant.
2. Details regarding the fees and payment deadlines are available on the conference website.
3. The conference fee must be paid by a bank transfer to the account provided by the organizer. Invoices will be issued upon request.
4. In the case of the participants who cancel after the deadline of April 12, 2026, the conference fee will not be refunded.

IV. Organization of the Conference

1. The conference will consist of plenary sessions, parallel sessions, and a poster session.
2. The conference program, including detailed information on the sessions, will be available on the conference website.
3. The organizer will provide the necessary conditions and technical resources for the presentation of scientific papers.

4. Participants are required to adhere to the conference schedule and organizational guidelines.

V. Copyright and Image Protection

1. By submitting scientific presentations, participants agree to publication of their abstracts and presentations in the conference materials.
2. Participants agree that the organiser may photograph and record the conference for documentation purposes.

VI. Privacy Policy

1. The conference organizer processes participants' personal data in accordance with applicable data protection regulations.
2. Participants' data will be used exclusively for purposes related to the organization of the conference, including contact with participants and sending information about future events.
3. Participants have the right to access their personal data, correct it and request its deletion.

VII. Final Provisions

1. The organizer reserves the right to amend these regulations. Any changes will be announced on the conference website.
